

On-Site Emergency Mock Drill

Division : SID II (Axis 1 & 2)

Location : Dust Shuttling Chamber.

Date : 27.09.2014

Time : 11.40 AM



Scenario Considered for Emergency Declaration :

There was a drop of hot dust from the Dust Settling Chamber & due to this hot dust, the LPG cylinder which being used near the DSC caught fire. Due to this workers who were working at the DSC platform & nearby area were exposed to fire. Four workers out of six workers presumed to be sustained burn injury. The fire to LPG near DSC & injuries to the worker forced to declare an emergency.

Other workers out of six, immediately conveyed the message to shift in-charge. Shift in-charge passed on message to control room. Control Room person with the consent of emergency controller, declared an emergency.

Immediately emergency was declared to evacuate and rescue the trapped people & also to bring an emergency in to normalcy.

All teams i.e. Rescue Team, Isolation Team, Fire Fighting Team, First Aid/Ambulance Team & Security Team were summoned to the site and all teams acted to control the emergency.
